PATROL TACTICAL VEST TRAINING

PHILOSOPHY:

It is the philosophy of the San Rafael Police Department to provide rapid response capabilities for in-progress and high risk crimes. To rely solely on the Special Response Team to respond immediately to resolve a high risk incident is not practical, nor advisable in every situation. Police Officers are often called upon to respond to high risk incidents and are expected to place themselves in danger in order to fulfill the Police Department's Mission. Therefore, the San Rafael Police Department will provide necessary equipment and training to all of its employees to allow patrol officers responding to a dangerous and immediate situation to minimize the danger to officers and citizens, and to control or isolate the situation.

GOAL:

The goal of the SRPD will be to provide all SRPD sworn personnel with the training and equipment to fulfill the Department's Mission. All sworn personnel will be issued ballistic helmets. SRPD vehicles will be equipped with a Level Three rated ballistic vest. Each vest will contain an extra rifle magazine and a trauma dressing. A .223 caliber rifle will be placed in each vehicle.

All sworn personnel will be trained on the use of the issued equipment and tactics to be used with the issued equipment.
