



The Chief has requested that Margo and I participate in a luncheon meeting he is chairing on August 2 from 1200 – 1400. Neither of us will available to administer the CLETS Less than Full Access Test that day. I hope you will be able to do it.

I will have the booklets ready for you on August 1 and can review the requirements for the testing so you can administer the test in our absence.

Simply put, we are administering this test in order to bring SRPD into compliance with DOJ training timelines pertaining to anyone who has access to or use of CLETS information.

Those in Phase Training who qualify under these parameters should write the name and the date on the outside of the booklet. They should read the booklet and answer the questions. It is permissible to look up the answers during the test.




